YAY!!!!!!! Regular production of the 2020 Chevrolet Corvette Stingray coupe began on February 3, 2020 at General Motors Bowling Green Assembly in Bowling Green, Kentucky. Initial vehicle shipments to dealers are expected to begin in late February or early March.

The NCRS sponsors higher education scholarship through Museum. "The NCRS Board wanted to give back to the NCM. The Museum's membership base is approximately 35,000 strong, while NCRS has about 15,000 members – so that's 20,000 enthusiasts that are not touched by NCRS," said Carlton Colclough, NCRS Representative on the National Corvette Museum Board of Directors. "We wanted to generate interest in the younger generation and get them interested. The students don't have to be attending college, it can be a tech school, or anything post high school education."

NCRS gifted 18 scholarships in 2019 through both NCRS and the NCRS Foundation totaling more than \$42,000.
