NATIONAL CORVETTE MUSEUM

Two new C7 colors are being introduced; Elkhart Lake Blue and Shadow Gray. Elkhart Lake replaces Admiral Blue while Shadow replaces Watkins Glen Gray.

Watkins Glen Gray, as of April 3, 2018, was the third most popular color for 2019 Corvettes with 15%. Admiral Blue was the 7th with 5 % of the 7070 produced.

June 28: GTR Admiral Blue – Last Day to Order

August 30: GS7 Elkhart Lake Blue – Available to Order

October 1: First Day of Production
